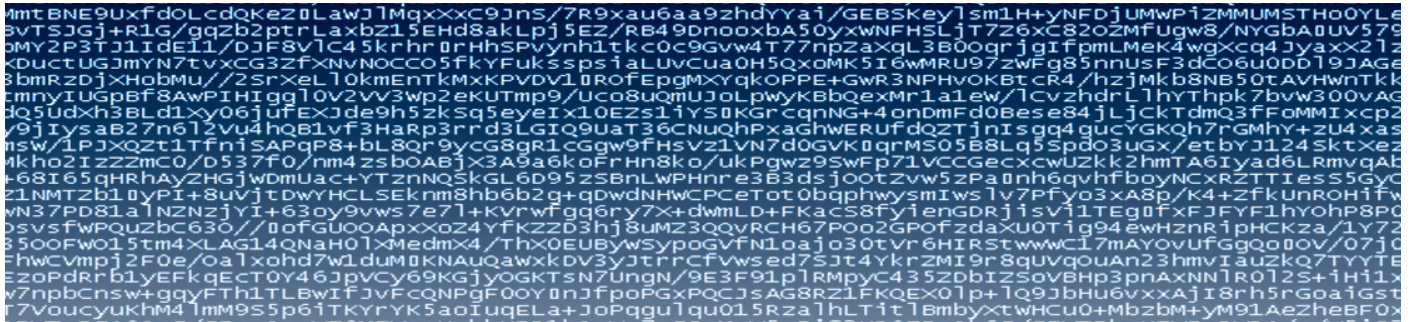


Lunch seminar at Security Arena, September 21

Hacker technique awareness



There are many techniques that hackers can use to break into computers. One way to categorize these techniques is to look at those attacks that are carried out through networks and those that are done physically at the computer.

The first demonstration is of an SQL injection attack, which shows how certain simple access controls can be bypassed. In addition it also touches on the subject of data leakage where the same technique is often used.

We follow up by demonstrating a few simple techniques to compromise an unattended computer through physical access. These techniques require as little time as a few seconds to a couple of minutes.

The seminar ends with some simple suggestions on how to protect against attacks such as these.
